

## QUESTIONS TO USE WITH THE PROCLAIMER or THE BIBLE ON RECORDING

For the group facilitator: Remember, IT IS NOT YOUR JOB TO ANSWER ALL THE GROUP'S QUESTIONS! You only need to get the group talking, to repeat what they heard, to think about it and to think about what it means and what they are going to do about it.

### If it was a story (The Gospels, Acts):

- What was the story we heard?
- Who were the main characters in the story?
- Which characters did you like? Why?
- Which characters were good examples to us? How?
- Which characters were poor examples to us? How or why?
- What did the main characters do?
  1. Why do you think..... did.....?
- What did they say?
- What did you learn that was new to you?
- What did you wonder about as you listened?
- How did you feel about what you heard?
- What will you do about what you heard?

### If it was teaching (the Epistles):

Who was writing the letter?

Why was the letter written?

What are some of the main teachings or main ideas?

Did you hear any words or phrases repeated?

Did you hear any contrasting words or phrases or ideas?

What did it teach about God?

What would you like to learn more about?

How did you feel about what you heard?

What will you do about what you heard?
